Game Directions:

Formation: Players sit in a circle on their knees, or back on their haunches. Each player has a pencil or stick. In time to the singing each player bangs the object down on the floor in front of the player to their right, and on alternate beats picks up the object that has been banged down in front of them. On the words “triqui, triqui tran”, each player taps three beats in a row on floor to their right, to their left, and then bangs the object down to their right. The object of the game is to eliminate those who break the rhythm or make mistakes. Play until most are eliminated, speeding up at will toward the end.
